Child Safety

Clifton Beach Surf Lifesaving Club along with Surf Lifesaving Tasmania and Surf Lifesaving Australia is committed to the ongoing safety of all children and are currently getting into action to ensure we are following the current Child Safe Policy and Program. The purpose of the Child Safe Program is to build the capacity to protect children and young people from physical, sexual, emotional abuse and neglect, and create environments which are supportive of positive and enjoyable experiences.

As the first step we need to ensure that all members over the age of 18 hold current registration to work with vulnerable people (RWVP).

If you do not hold RWVP you must commence the application prior to this season's membership renewals. If you do hold RWVP but have not added Clifton Beach as a volunteer organisation you are required to do this too. Nippers Sessions

Please arrive 15 minutes early for each session. Nippers should wear a club cap and high vis vest; club bathers are optional. Children will gather in their age group lines and then move to roll call by their age manager in a designated area. U6 & U7 parents need to accompany their kids; others stay on the beach, potentially assisting with various tasks. Inform the manager of your location. Sessions include diverse beach and water activities, tailored to age and ability, encouraging everyone to participate.

Carnivals

Carnivals are for Nipper U8 and above who have completed their proficiencies. At a carnival your child will have the opportunity to compete individually and in team events. Events include beach flags, running events, swimming, iron person and board races. It is a wonderful opportunity for your child to be part of a statewide competition. The emphasis is on having fun and participating. Parents/guardians must be present at the carnivals at all times.

Entries:

Entries for carnivals will be advertised through the carnival channel on the Stack Teams App. To enter your child please fill in the google doc. Entries will close for OUR club approximately 10 days before the event so teams can be formed and entered. Please remember that if your child is not registered with us 10 days prior, they may miss out on being in some team events.

How can you help at a carnival:

- Tow the gear trailer
- Help load and unload the trailer
- Volunteers as an official, this can be as simple as filming the end of a race with an ipad.

What to bring to a carnival:

- SLSA red wrist band
- Clifton Beach SLSC cap
- Swim cap and googles
- High vis vest
- Food and water
- Two towels
- Warm jacket

Active Seniors	\$170	 Note that any members under the age of 18 MUST have at least one parent or carer registered as a member. A child cannot be involved in nippers until they turn 5. Age groups for all Surf Lifesaving members are calculated by the current age as at midnight on September 30th of each year. For example, a child that is 9 years of age as of September 30th will be categorised as U10 Nipper for the coming season.




