Strangely enough the format for the event was the same as Janes race. Well done Mary be "Proud of your Achievement."

Skis for Open females was introduced in early 1990's as a single ski event and in either season of 1996 or 1997 it was approved for the ski leg in Open Iron woman.

When the ski leg was introduced in Iron woman event several of the top **Aussie Ironwomen** stopped racing as they didn't want to do the ski leg.
